The Bendigo Mountain Bike Club can confirm that we will not be running our much anticipated 6HR race - Round 6 of the Victorian Endurance Series – scheduled for Sunday 9th September. We offer our apologies to all riders and hope to be back in 2019.

As a club, we are extremely disappointed not to be able to offer our 6HR event this year – particularly following the very successful Bendigo MTB Festival run at Andy’s Trail Network in 2017. The club has worked extremely hard in building this event and offering a range of racing opportunities to riders of all abilities and in varying formats. The live streaming of the World Cup in Cairns from our truck mounted TV on day 1 and the XCE racing on day 2 last year being particular highlights.

The club had hoped to be racing at Andy’s Trail Network – unfortunately a range of planning restrictions has resulted in us not having access for this event. We are extremely grateful to the landowners who have worked tirelessly to assist the club in providing what is a fantastic venue for riding and racing.

The Bendigo Mountain Bike Club actively pursue trail advocacy for mountain bikers in our Parks – we work closely with key stakeholders at local, state and federal government level. We seek to be responsible users and custodians.
