GETTING THERE from Bendigo - [Google Maps: Daltons Road](#)

Taking the first Castlemaine/Harcourt exit off the Calder Fwy, travel 8km into Castlemaine. Turn right at Parker St (computer shop on corner). Parker St becomes Walker St at rail crossing. Continue straight. At the top of hill follow the road around to the right and continue on Richards Rd (with Don KR factory on left). Follow road around to left and continue up hill on Daws Rd. At the top of the hill look for MTB event signage. Daltons Road (unsealed) will be on your right.

- Registration & Plate Collection: 9.00AM – 10.00AM
- Dirt Squirts (500m) and Recreational Riders (1.7km) Event: 10.00AM to 10.25AM
- Rider Briefing: 10.20AM
- Grade Racing Starts in wave order A, B, C, D, E: 10.30am



- Grades A, B, C & D will race 3.65km course, Grades E will race 1.7km course. Please refer to attached map.
- Presentations: 11.45AM

- Car parking will be along Daltons Road.
- Please cooperate with marshals and park in the most efficient orientation possible.

- First Aid will be on-site. If you come across an injured rider please render assistance or send another rider to notify First Aid personal.

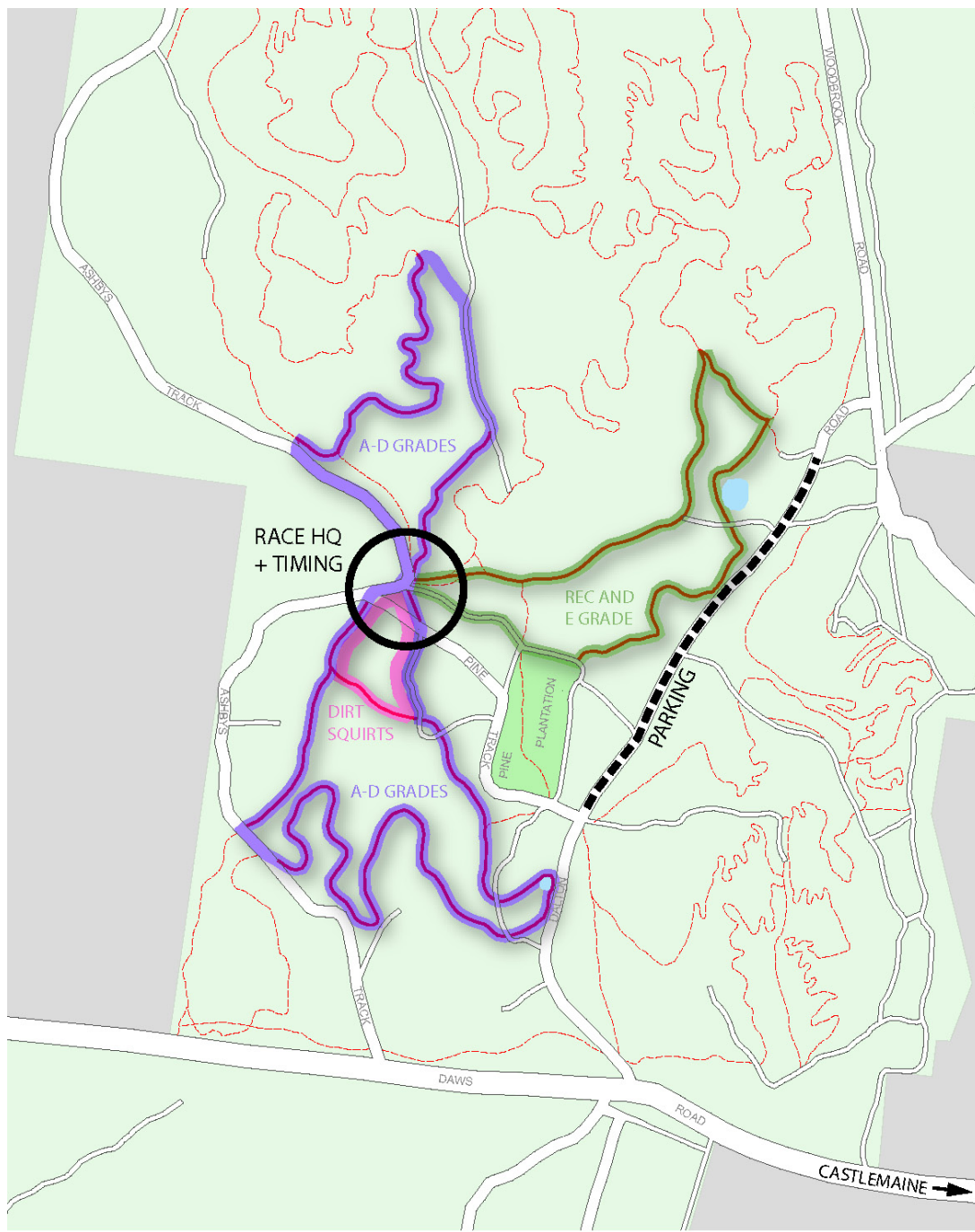
Rider Etiquette:
